## Improving the quality of communication in healthcare

To achieve this aim EACH uses a variety of strategies and activities are overseen by 3 major subcommittees: pEACH, rEACH & tEACH focussing on policy / advocacy / implementation, research and teaching respectively.







The aim of **rEACH** is to promote good quality communication research within EACH and to support the development of high quality researchers.

rEACH has active working groups on:

- Training
- Summer School planning
- Funding
- Tools

Recent **rEACH** achievements:

- rEACH has successfully filled its Summer School with 11 delegates (early career researchers) that takes place alongside the Summer Event in London, UK (4 - 8 September 2017)
- The funding group submitted a multicentre COST ACTION application and are awaiting the outcome
- All the working groups have a work plan that is currently underway with deliverables. For example: the Tools group intend placing the first edition of a catalogue of coding tools up on the EACH website in the near future

The aim of **tEACH** is to be a primary source of help for communication teachers everywhere. **tEACH** is composed of more than 40 working members representing a variety of health care disciplines and more than 21 countries from around the world.

**Support:** sharing of expertise and support through consultations and site visits

Training: annual courses focusing on 'What' and 'How' to teach communication skills, 'Curriculum Development' and 'Assessment'; local courses within countries/institutions; and a Certificate of In-Depth Study in Communication Education

Tools: over 100 teaching and assessment tools are available on the EACH website via a searchable online database including facilitator guides, simulated patient cases and comprehensive curriculum

Networking: acces to national networks to foster development and collaboration of communication teachers including a new find-a-colleague site for meeting and sharing of expertise
