- Processes of training or standardising those who assess or observe communication;
- Efforts to influence policy (of education institutions or health systems) relating the evaluation/assessment of communication skills;
- Assessment of communication skills as it relates to efforts to improve patient care.

Communication could be part of each of the conference themes. Include communication as a keyword or in the title of your abstract submission to ensure it is included in the communication stream.
