## Request for an opinion on the proposal titled: 'SURVEY: Assessing clinical communication skills teaching Covid19 in undergraduate health care education'

1.Regarding your request dated May 28, 2024, on the above matter, I wish to inform you that after reviewing the content of the documents you have submitted, the National Bioethics Committee of Cyprus (EEBK) has issued a positive opinion in favor of conducting the said research."

2. The Committee wishes to emphasize that the responsibility for conducting the research remains yours, in a manner that complies with the provisions of the new European General Data Protection Regulation (2016/679) and the Law on the Protection of Natural Persons against the Processing of Personal Data and the Free Movement of Such Data of 2018 (Law No. 125(I)/2018), as amended.

3. We inform you that if another study with the same or similar subject is being reviewed at the same time, the National Bioethics Committee of Cyprus (EEBK) publishes the research topic on its website, along with information on the research, the organization, and the researcher, in order to facilitate better coordination and avoid repetition

4. During the course of conducting the research, the coordinator/scientific supervisor is obliged to inform the EEBK (National Bioethics Committee of Cyprus) about any modifications to the protocol or other research documents and will submit the required revised documents to the Committee

5. In the event of discontinuation of the research, the coordinator/scientific supervisor must immediately and in writing inform the Committee, providing reasons for the discontinuation
