## Early achievements track record

3. Trained as qualitative researcher, I’ve applied a broad range of qualitative methods and techniques – qualitative interviews, focus groups, inductive analysis of videos, participant observations. I’ve also conducted multi- and mixed-method studies, and literature reviews.
4. As research psychologist, I’ve always worked inside hospitals in interdisciplinary teams, especially with doctors and patients/caregivers but also with statisticians, linguists, philosophers, health economists and nurses.
